Arizona Public Service (APS) (Discount on energy utilities for medical equipment)

For individuals in the home who have a life-threatening illness or use critical medical equipment that requires electricity, you may qualify for a 35% discount on you monthly energy bill.

Arizona Public Service (APS) (Electric utility bill assistance)

Energy Support Program, which offers a discount up to 25 percent off the cost of electricity bills for those qualified customers who meet certain household income guidelines, Crisis Bill Assistance: Customers in a temporary financial bind may qualify for up to \$800 per year in payment assistance to help cover their energy bills.

<u>Lifeline (Phone and internet discount program)</u>

Lifeline is a federal program dedicated to making phone and internet service more affordable for low-income households. This benefit provides eligible consumers with a monthly discount of up to \$9.25. Consumers living on Tribal lands are eligible for an enhanced discount of up to \$34.25 per month.

<u>Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (Resource of the Department of Economic Security)</u>
